Buddies' 45th anniversary season continues next month with *The Rocky Mountain Special*, written, composed, and performed by Calgary-based songstress, theatre maker, and artist activist **Tiffany Thomas**. Tiffany (The Stratford Festival, Lunchbox Theatre, National Arts Centre, Musical Stage Company) brings a new iteration of her musical to the iconic Tallulah's Cabaret at Buddies. Soaring vocals, stirring lyrics, and scathing self-expression collide onboard *The Rocky Mountain Special*, a legendary bus tour through mountains, memes, displacement and dreams.

Searching for her Ancestors aboard a dilapidated Greyhound bus in a post-Wexit wasteland, an aging transfeminine songwriter is haunted by her cringeworthy younger self. Waking dreams, ancestors, and the pavement beneath, this one-woman musical tour-de-force takes audiences along for an epic, musical ride.

The Rocky Mountain Special was presented as Zach (she/her) at Intrepid Theatre Club and the National Arts Centre, and received further development support through Buddies' Seeding Work program in the 2022/23 season. The piece was first conceived in a residency at The Sunset Theatre in Wells BC, and various iterations of the story and songs appeared as Kohkum & me at the Calgary Fringe, and later as a concert confessional called Zach (she/her), at Intrepid Theatre and The National Arts Centre. In The Rocky Mountain Special, Tiffany fully reimagines the story and characters into a brand new musical with designs by Anna Dalgleish and Kat Armstrong, transforming this memoir fantasia for the Buddies space and an audience old and young. Each performance will also be accompanied by a different local musical act following the play.
